A RESOLUTION MAKING FINDINGS AND DIRECTING FILING OF NOTICE OF EXEMPTION, PURSUANT TO CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT, PLANT OUTFALL MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR PROJECT

The Board of Directors of the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District, Marin County finds and determines as follows:

- A. The District has plans and specifications prepared to rehabilitate the treatment plant's outfall line near the mouth of Richardson Bay, CA, to maintain reliability and capacity, and to satisfy permit requirements. Work includes the replacement of thirty duckbill difussers and repair of eight pipe restraints.
- B. The proposed project has a Categorical Exemption under State and Local Guidelines adopted pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act.

In consideration of the foregoing finding and determinations,

IT IS RESOLVED by the Board of Directors as follows:

- 1. That this Board finds and determines said project is categorically exempt pursuant to the provisions of State and Local guidelines adopted pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act as a Class 2 exemption (Section 15302(c) of CEQA Guidelines) in that it is a: Replacement or reconstruction of existing utility systems and/or facilities involving negligible or no expansion of capacity.
- 2. The Secretary is directed and authorized to file a copy of said Notice of Exemption, with a certified copy of this Resolution attached, in the District office and in the office of the County Clerk of the County of Marin.
