**RESOLUTION TO REAFFIRM CALPERS PENSION PROGRAM EMPLOYER PAID MEMBER
CONTRIBUTIONS**

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District has the authority to implement Government Code Section 20691; and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District has a written labor policy or contract with CalPERS dated December 23, 1985 which specifically provides for the normal member contributions to be paid by the employer; and

WHEREAS, one of the steps in the procedures to implement Section 20691 is the adoption by the governing body of the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District of a Resolution to commence said Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC); and

WHEREAS, the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District wishes to adopt this resolution that reaffirms the District's Employer Paid Member Contributions (EPMC); and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District has identified the following conditions for the purpose of its election to pay EPMC:

- This benefit shall apply to all regular and qualified employees covered under District's CalPERS pension program, excluding employees as defined under the 2013 California Public Employees' Pension Reform Act (PEPRA).
- This benefit shall consist of paying 8 percent, of the normal member contributions as EPMC.
- The effective date of this Resolution shall be October 18, 2003.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the governing body of the Sausalito-Marin City Sanitary District reaffirms its election to pay EPMC, as set forth above.




